Criteria: Applicants must have an immediate family member, blood relative, or adopted, involved with a war or conflict that is recognized by the American Legion. Immediate family members to include (and/or): Grandfather, Grandmother, Father, Mother, Brother, or Sister. The student who receives this scholarship must show proof to the membership of the American Legion Post #30 that their relation (he/she) has served in the Armed Forces. Proper paperwork and/or DD214 are requires for verification before the scholarship is awarded.

Special consideration will be given to student(s) who qualify that have a family member(s) who are/were: Prisoner of War, Missing In Action, recipients of the Purple Heart, and students who volunteer with the American Legion Post #30.

In the event that two or more students qualify for the scholarship, he/she may be requires to submit a typed essay of two or more pages to the membership of the American Legion Post #30 on the subject of how their family member(s) serving/served in the Armed Forces has effected their development as a student of their respective school, citizen of their local community and country, how they personally feel about the Armed Forces, and how it effect the world today.
