

The Independence Garden Club College Scholarship Class of 2010

The Independence Garden Club is offering a one time award of a \$250 scholarship to a senior student graduation from Jefferson High School in Independence, Iowa.

The amount of the scholarship or number of scholarships provided may vary from year to year and may be omitted if monies are not available.

The application deadline is established by the Dollars for Scholars Committee.

ELIGIBILITY:

Students demonstrating involvement in school activities and in the community.

Students with a 3.0 grade point average and leadership qualities.

Students planning to attend any accredited institution of higher education in Iowa (i.e. Jr. College, Community College, Technical College, College or University)

Students must plan to major in Horticulture, Floral Design, Landscape/Garden Design, Plant pathology, Entomology, Botany, Agronomy, Animal Ecology, Forestry or some related field.

The student must have submitted a completed application form to Dollars for Scholars with this application form by the deadline they have established.

PROCESS:

During the selection process your name will not be known. Applications from qualifying students will be compiled by the Dollars for Scholars Committee and given to three members of the Independence Garden Club. They will individually rate them and return them to the Dollars for Scholars Committee. When the recipient's name is known, they (and their parents) will be invited to attend one of the Garden Club meetings for a social time and to have you give an informal discussion about yourself and future plans.

Within one full year and upon completion of the first semester or quarter, the recipient is responsible to have a copy of their transcript sent to the Independence Dollars for Scholars Committee. A check for the \$250 scholarship is sent in the recipient's name, to the appropriate institution, from the Dollars for Scholars fund, if the grades are satisfactory. Each individual school determines additional or matching monies. If the recipient does not complete these requirements, the money will be held in reserve with the Independence Dollars for Scholars fund until another individual is eligible and selected the following year.

1. List the name, location and dates of attendance of ALL High Schools you have attended.
2. Have school officials attach to this application form a record of your

Class ranking, without your name.
3. Provide a letter of recommendation, preferably from a faculty member that does NOT state your name.
4. List your school related organizations and extracurricular activities. Note if you had a leadership role.
5. List your involvement in community activities during your high school years. Note any leadership roles.
6. List your hobbies or special interests not listed above.
7. List job experiences (after school – summer) and how that has impacted your career choice.
8. Give the name and location of the school that you plan to attend.
9. State your career goals and time frame to achieve them.
10. State how this scholarship will help meet your needs, why you should be considered for it and any special financial circumstances we should be aware of.
